

We Help Ourselves (WHOS)

We are seeking part-time AOD Worker for our Family Support Liaison Project

WHOS (We Help Ourselves) is based in NSW and QLD, and caters for individuals who are experiencing difficulties with Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) dependence. Our programs are based on the Therapeutic Community model of care.

We require self-initiating, motivated and experienced applicants to fill this role which will be based at our site at Lilyfield (former Rozelle Hospital). The successful applicants will be required to provide family and friend's orientation groups to WHOS clients, assist clients to re-establish or strengthen their relationship with family and friends, and support our clients' family and friends with the introduction to external family support agencies. This position reports to the WHOS Family Support Manager and will be expected to contribute to policy development and maintain data records in relation to KPIs relating to this project.

Requirements include:- Experience in the Alcohol & Other Drug Field, experience working with FACS or knowledge of FACS practises, experience with group-work, a current drivers licence.

Remuneration: Negotiated dependant on qualifications and experience equivalent to SCHC&D Award. Successful applicants will need to provide current Police Record Check.
