We have available both full-time or part-time **(PT days / hours negotiable)** AOD worker positions. The positions involve:

- a) providing AOD assessment, referral, and education,
- b) supervising and supporting clients in a residential setting,
- c) implementing a structured daily program
- d) facilitation of groups
- e) providing therapeutic interventions.
- f) compliance with internal policy and procedure and clinical governance processes

1. Minimum qualification Certificate IV Community Services or other relevant qualifications.
2. Experience with or capacity to work with clients that have AOD use disorders and associated conditions.
3. Knowledge of and capacity to implement harm reduction strategies.
4. Available to work a rotating roster. NOTE Evening shift includes a sleepover shift.
5. COVID-19 vaccination certificate (WHOS adheres to the NSW Health recommendations for vaccination).
6. First Aid Certificate
7. Ability to facilitate groups.
