The Service

WHOS Hub – Nambour welcomes anyone seeking help with a substance or alcohol use problem, in a safe, non-judgemental environment. Our services are designed to assist people on their recovery journey, no matter what stage they are at.

Pre and Post Treatment

Pre-treatment offers support through group work and case management while preparing to enter WHOS Nambour residential service. Groups run 3 days per week for 3 hours.

Post treatment offers support for people who have left the residential service, providing case management and group work, topics include budgeting and employment readiness.

The Program

Things to consider

WHOS provides a comprehensive assessment and referral service, as well as the day program which consists of group work and individual support provided by experienced drug and alcohol workers.

The three service streams offered are:

1. Referrals to relevant services
2. Case management – appointment based
3. Day Program – Group work over 6 week cycle plus individual support sessions.

The day program operates on a six-week rotating cycle which includes group work and individual support sessions
