The role involves:

- a) assessment, referral, and education,
- b) supervising and supporting clients in a residential setting,
- c) delivering a structured daily program (which includes facilitating various processes and groups),
- d) conducting therapeutic interventions

TO BE CONSIDERED APPLICANTS MUST RESPOND TO THE SELECTION CRITERIA BELOW

1. Certificate IV or higher in AOD, Community Services, Mental Health or other related field.
2. Ability to work a rotating roster - day, evening and weekend shifts as required.
3. Experience in or knowledge of facilitating groups.
4. Experience in or knowledge of residential treatment services.
5. Experience in or knowledge of working with clients that have AOD and associated conditions.
6. Knowledge and understanding of harm minimisation strategies.
7. Full driver's licence

Being male is a genuine requirement for this position, *under Section 14 of the Anti-Discrimination Act 1977 (NSW)*.
