Aboriginal Alcohol and Other Drugs Worker Full Time / Part-Time

This position is available to Aboriginal people only.

We Help Ourselves (WHOS) provides a range of alcohol and other drug (AOD) treatment programs in NSW and Queensland. Information on the range of services provided by WHOS can be found at www.whos.com.au

WHOS Hawkesbury Region Day Program, located at Windsor, has a full-time position available for an Aboriginal AOD Worker. The position is 38 hours per week. This position is offered on a full-time basis; however, part-time arrangements may be considered for the right candidate.

Key responsibilities for the position are to provide the WHOS Day Program range of services to clients in a culturally appropriate and sensitive manner. This includes the use of WHOS assessment and care planning tools, and group work materials, training on the use of these will be provided.

The successful applicant will:

- Support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients to engage, and remain engaged, with the WHOS Hawkesbury Region Day Program
- Support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients as they address harms caused by AOD use
- Provide AOD
- Contribute to the culturally appropriate provision of AOD assessment, case management, one to one & group support information sessions
- Liaise with allied service providers, in particular Aboriginal service providers

Applicants must submit a resume and provide a cover letter that addresses the selection criteria below:

1. Experience and/or a qualification in AOD, Community Services, Aboriginal Health, or related fields
2. Knowledge of AOD, mental health services in the region
3. Knowledge of Aboriginal specific AOD, health and community services in the Hawkesbury region
4. Knowledge of AOD Harm Reduction approach
5. Sound written and verbal communication skills
6. Current First Aid Certificate, or willingness to obtain
7. Current driver's licence

Being an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person is a genuine occupational requirement for this position.

Remuneration: SCHADSI Award, Level 4 Pay qualifications and experience.

Applicants must provide a current National Police Clearance Check.
